Dear Sir/Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that the second phase of the pedestrian improvement works around Breach Road and Clay Lake will begin week commencing 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020. The works are anticipated to last for approximately 2 weeks.

In accordance with the Consultation drawing previously issued, the works will include:

- Installation of a Vehicle Activated Sign on the approach to the new uncontrolled pedestrian crossing point near Broad Lane
- Installation of a Speed Indication Device on the approach to Brown Edge village from Clay Lake
- Removal of existing 40mph roundel signage and posts along Breach Road/Clay Lake between Greenfield Avenue and Stoney Lane.
- Install new road markings adjacent to newly installed Pedestrian Crossing warning signs on the approach to the recently constructed uncontrolled crossing point near Broad Lane.

Following completion of the signage works, the new 30mph speed limit will be enforceable from 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
